

Grant Evaluation Criteria & Scoring

Community Engaged Project Grant

Review of the application materials must focus on the following criteria:

- **Logistics.**
 - The application clearly states what will be done by whom, when and where things will take place, and how this project will happen both logistically and financially.
- **Artistic Vibrancy and Impact.**
 - Art is central to this project.
 - The artist/artists will provide a positive and purposeful experience for the participants.
 - This project provides access or engages underserved communities as identified by the NEA. Refer to the intended participants/audience the applicant identified under “Logistics.”
- **Community Engagement.**
 - This project consists of active, two-way, meaningful engagement with the identified intended community.
 - This project and artist/artists welcome non and new artists to engage in making, experiencing, or learning about art as an active participant.

For each application, assign a rating from the list of the following statements:

- 5: This application is excellent, I strongly recommend that this application advances in the selection process.
- 4: This application is good, I recommend that this application advances in the selection process.
- 3: This application is okay, I am unsure if this application should receive funding.
- 2: This application needs improvement, I recommend that this application does not receive funding.
- 1: I strongly recommend that this application does not receive funding.
